ABSTRACT

Improve upon existing encryption technology to tailor encrypted messages to recipient in a format that can be sent plain text (e.g. by voice).

Using the principle of public key encryption, use the psycho-physical public/private key of the recipient to encrypt a message using words the recipient will psychoacoustically translate back to unencrypted form.
